Mac[®] OS X 10.10 or later


Suggestion


To ensure there is sufficient power provided to JetFlash Vault, you are suggested to insert it directly to a USB 3.0 (or 2.0) port on your desktop or notebook. Avoid connecting JetFlash Vault to devices that feature an extra USB port such as USB-powered hub or keyboard.

2. Setting a Password and Hint (Windows)

Before using your JetFlash Vault, you are advised to set a password and hint to protect your data on the JetFlash Vault.

- 1. Insert the JetFlash Vault into an available USB port on your notebook or desktop.
- 2. Open File Explorer and click **DVD RW JetFlash Vault** on the left. Then double-click **JetFlashVault_Launcher** to launch JetFlash Vault.








3. Set a password and re-enter your password.

Note: Password needs to be at least 6 characters and include 3 of the following characters: Upper case letters, lower case letters, digits and special characters.


Warning! Please remember your password well. For security reason, if you forget your password, you will have to format the device before next use.

Formatting the device will erase all data stored on JetFlash Vault.




4. Set a Hint (Optional). The hint can be helpful in providing a clue in case you forget your password. Click **OK** to finish password and hint setting.

Note: The hint cannot be too similar to your password.





3. Start Using JetFlash Vault (Windows)


- Insert the JetFlash Vault into an available USB port on your notebook or desktop.
- 2. Open File Explorer and click **DVD RW JetFlash Vault** on the left. Then double-click **JetFlashVault Launcher** to launch JetFlash Vault.



3. Enter your password, then click **Login**.

Warning! The preset maximum incorrect login attempt is 10. If you reach the limit, you must format your JetFlash Vault and reset a password. Formatting the device will erase all data stored on JetFlash Vault.

- Click Forget Password to format your JetFlash Vault and set a new password.
- Click **Hint** to show the hint you set.
- You can set your Contact Information in JetFlash Vault settings
- Check the Read Only box if you want to use JetFlash Vault in Read-only mode. In Read-only mode, you can only view files, but not format JetFlash Vault, update, change or delete any content.



4. Once logged in, you will be able to use JetFlash Vault.


4. JetFlash Vault Options (Windows)


